

## Release Notes for CHRIS Release 15.6 March 14, 2008

### **CHRIS User:**

New display of **User Name: Last Name, First Name**, identifies the person who logged into CHRIS. It appears at the top of the CHRIS screen, after "CHRIS (Production)".

### **CHRIS Animation:**

Introduction of animation in a few of the CHRIS screens.

### **Investigation:**

Path: Workload/Investigate/Findings/Central Registry Release button

- The envelope printing function is restored for the Letter to Requestor and the List to Offender
- The State Letterhead and Footer were added to the computer generated letter, so Central Registry Staff will no longer have to insert a blank official letterhead into their printer.

### **Case:**

#### **Enter/Exit Placement Screen**

Path: Workload/Placement/Place/Enter/Exit

- A new mandatory picklist, Adoptive Benefits, will appear when a CHRIS User exits a foster child from care for the Reason of Adoption. The picklist selections are:
  - Federal Subsidy
  - Federal Subsidy Declined-Med Accepted
  - Not Subsidy Eligible
  - State Subsidy No Medicaid
  - State Subsidy with Medicaid
  - Subsidy Declined-Medicaid Declined

#### **Assets Screen – DHS Foster Care Trust Transactions by Client**

Path: Workload/Client/Finances/Assets/Trust Accounts Details Button

- A new "**Reference**" column to display comments regarding the specific Account/Activity/Amount, such as a Board Payment Reimbursement, a date of SSA Electronic File Transfer on SSI payment, or a date of Child Support Enforcement Unit's payments and check number (helpful when funds are returned to OCSE)

### **Eligibility Unit:**

#### **EU Inbox**

Path: Inbox (logged in as a DCFS IV-E Eligibility Unit staff)

- The following new adoption Changes will appear in the Change Type/Medicaid Indicator column in the Eligibility Unit's Inbox based on the selection of the new Adoptive Benefits when the child leaves foster care due to Adoption:
  - Adopted-Federal Subsidy
  - Adopted-FedSubsidyDeclined with Medicaid
  - Adopted-Not Subsidy Eligible

- Adopted-State Subsidy No Medicaid
  - Adopted-State Subsidy with Medicaid
  - Adopted-Subsidy Declined No Medicaid
- The following existing Change has been removed:
  - “Placed for Adoption” Change
- The following Changes which appear in the Eligibility Unit’s Inbox along with the child’s IMA may now be Submitted before the child’s IMA is Submitted:
  - Placement/Address Change
  - Begin Trial Home Visit
  - End Trial Home Visit
  - Begin Detention
  - End Detention
  - Begin Runaway
  - End Runaway
