

Are You Eligible for SNAP?

In order to participate in the E&T Program, you must receive SNAP benefits. To see if you are eligible for SNAP benefits, visit your local county office or visit www.access.arkansas.gov.

How to Use Access Arkansas

1. Go to www.access.arkansas.gov
2. To see if you are eligible for SNAP, click "Am I Eligible?"
3. To apply for SNAP, click "New User" and create a new account.


The E&T Program helps Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) recipients who are able-bodied adults...

SNAP recipients who are

- between the ages of 18 – 49;
- subject to work registration;
- residents of a selected county that has chosen to operate an E&T Program;
- unemployed or employed less than 20 hours per week; or
- volunteers** (contact your county DHS office to see if you can volunteer).
