### **One-stop Assistance Event for Tornado Survivors to be Held in Mayflower**

The Arkansas Voluntary Organizations Active in Disaster (ARVOAD) is conducting a one-day assistance event from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Friday, May 16 at the House of Refuge and Deliverance, 748 Highway 365 South in Mayflower, Ark., to offer services to those affected by the April 27, 2014 tornadoes.
