SECTION 100 - EMPLOYMENT

101 Working Together



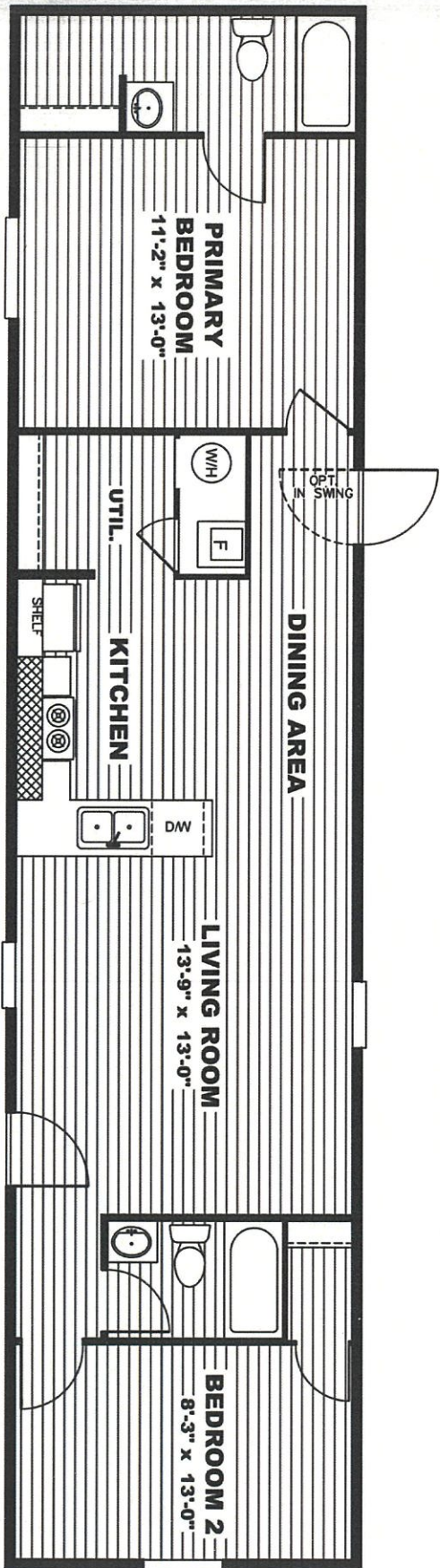

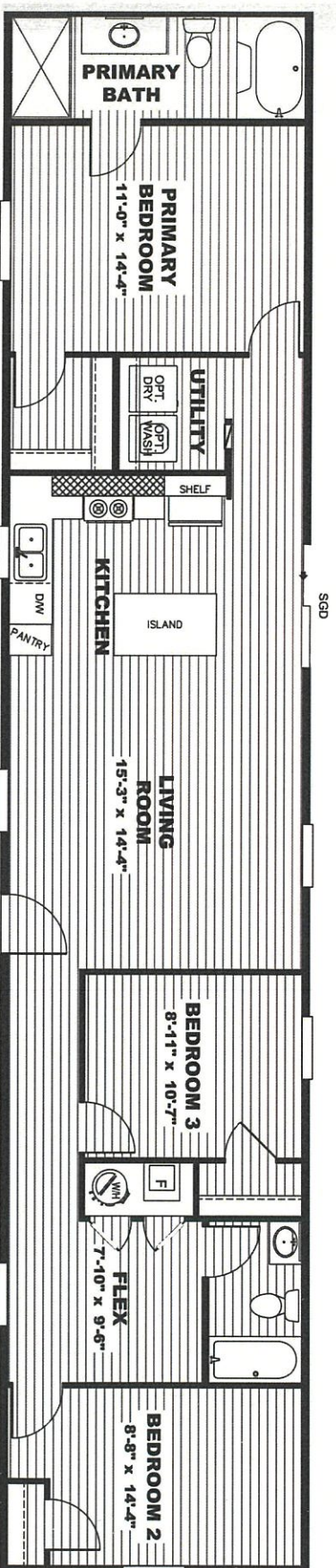
