Revised Cost Justification

The revised proposed cost for providing Supervised Independent Living are as follows: Previously proposed Residential Program cost was \$165.00, new revised Residential Program cost is \$160.00; previously proposed Apartment cost was \$95.00, new revised Apartment cost is \$90.00; previously proposed Shared Housing cost was \$95.00, new Shared Housing cost is \$90.00. To account for the cost revision, Arbor House will modify youth recreational activities.

The cost is very reasonable based on the following:

- Arbor House can provide both residential and apartment living
- Convenience: Arbor House is located three blocks from the Washington Avenue DHS Office
- Excellent relationships with local DHS Office and community
- Specially trained and licensed personnel
- Proven success with older, difficult to deal with youth
- Unique Afrocentric treatment model
- No direct charges for counseling and other mental health services

Arbor House History and Qualifications:

The name of the company submitting the proposal is A1 U.S. Company, Inc. The Company operates under the name Arbor House. Arbor House is a licensed residential facility in good standing with the Child Welfare Agency Review Board (see licensure previously provided). Arbor House was contracted by Division of Children and Family Services to provide residential services (group home) for errant youth from 2007 to 6/2019. Arbor House, utilized as a restrictive setting for older youth, is located at 2401 E. 2nd Street, North Little Rock 72114, within a few blocks from the Washington Avenue street Department of Human Services Office. Arbor House Apartment, utilized as a less restrictive setting for older youth, is located at 1319 and 1321 W. 39th North Little Rock, 72118. Both properties are owned by Antimoore Jackson and ready to be utilized for resident placement at this time. Arbor House has a close, excellent working relationship with caseworkers and supervisors at the North Little Rock DCFS office as well as leadership at Central Office. Arbor is uniquely positioned to offer a specialized Afrocentric perspective in working with errant youth in the community.

Higher in Level of Care for the Specific Youth Population

Historically Arbor House has been referred older youth who are chronically delinquent in behavior. These particular youth and their families represent the most challenging population to supervise and manage in the community in terms of severity of behavioral health conditions. Consequently, the higher level of care merits appropriate compensation.

Qualification of Arbor House Staff

It may be that DCFS can obtain a less expensive provider than Arbor House; however, it is very doubtful that another provider will offer a more experienced, qualified, and proven staff and setting. The staff will include the following:

Antimoore Jackson will work as director/administrator, has 38 years of experience, a doctorate degree in social work from Jackson State University at Jackson, Mississippi, a master's degree in social work from University of Arkansas at Little Rock and is dual licensed at the independent-provider level as a clinical social worker and addiction counselor in the state of Arkansas. Both licenses are in good standing (see resume and licenses previously provided).

Mr. Adrian Love will work as case manager, has 20 plus years of experience, BA degree in education, and certified as a paraprofessional (see resume and other documents previously provided)

Mr. Antimoore Jackson, Jr. will work as residential group-home worker, has 5 years of experience, and two years of college at Philander Smith College (see resume and other documents previously provided).

The plan is to hire additional staff as needed.


