What is ARChoices in Homecare Waiver?

ARChoices in Homecare ("ARChoices") is a Medicaid waiver program that provides home and community-based services to eligible adults with physical disabilities and people aged 65 or older.

How Does ARChoices help beneficiaries?

The ARChoices Waiver helps beneficiaries do everyday activities that they may no longer be able to do for themselves, like bathing, dressing, getting around their home, preparing meals, or doing household chores.

what are the eligibility requirements?

To be eligible to receive services through the ARChoices Waiver, applicants must meet **all** of the following requirements:

- 1. Be aged 21 through 64 years old with a physical disability OR be aged 65 and older
- 2. Meet established financial criteria
- 3. Meet the nursing home admission level of care criteria
