What is HCBS?

HCBS help Medicaid beneficiaries receive care in their own home or community.

Who benefits from HCBS?

This type of care is for people who need help with everyday activities. For example, people with physical disabilities, mental health illnesses, intellectual or developmental disabilities, and older adults.

What HCBS Programs are in Arkansas?

Arkansas Medicaid has several programs that help people receive HCBS. Each program has its own eligibility rules around types of disabilities, personal needs, housing, and financial situation. Some people may qualify for more than one program and can choose the best program for their life situation.
